By These Presents, Be it known that



The required number of duly qualified persons having applied for a Charter establishing a Post of AMVETS, and such application having been approved;

Now therefore, in accordance with the Constitution of AMVETS (American Veterans) this Charter is granted, and those applying, together with such others as may unite with them, are hereby authorized to establish and maintain a Post of AMVETS in the city of **Hayward** to be known as **AMVETS Post 911**, in the Department of **California**, unless revoked or suspended, shall be conclusive evidence of the lawful existence thereof.

By acceptance of this Charter, **AMVETS Post 911** acknowledges jurisdiction and declares itself to be subject to the National Constitution and Bylaws of AMVETS and of the Department of **California** and the rules, regulations and policies promulgated pursuant thereof; and further, **AMVETS Post 911**, Constitution of the United States and the Declaration of Principles of AMVETS.

In Witness Whereof, this Charter is given under the hand of the National Commander of AMVETS and duly attested to at AMVETS National Headquarters in Lanham, Maryland, this **Fourth** day of **September**, **2013**, and countersigned by the Commander and Adjutant of the Department of **California** this 5th day of September, **2013**.
